| <p>Things to consider</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Do not use an online translator but make judicious use of dictionaries and helpful websites/resources (see suggestions below). - Consider limiting the amount of text on each slide and referring to postcards for your notes. - Ensure you have carefully proof-read and spell-checked your presentation. - Will you read a script or refer to bullet point notes? - Speak clearly and slowly and project your voice. - Consider producing a vocabulary list to provide for other members of the class if you use any unusual or advanced vocabulary in your presentation. |
